FRIAR JOHN COR

Father of Scotch Whisky

History's first mention of Scotch whisky can be dated to 1494. An entry in the royal Exchequer Rolls (basically a record of taxation and government spending) from that year reads:

“Eight bolls of malt to Friar John Cor wherewith to make aqua vitae”

a “boll” is an archaic unit of measure equal to 64 pecks



Scotch Whisky must be bottled no lower than 40% alcohol by volume and no higher than 63.5%

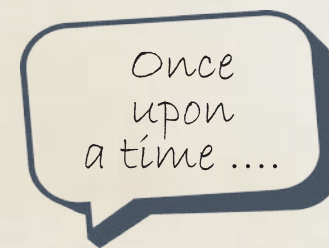

IRISH WHISKIES

The word 'whiskey' (or whisky) comes from the Irish (or 'Gaelic') Uisce Beatha, meaning water of life. Irish whiskey was one of the earliest distilled drinks in Europe, arising around the 12th century

The oldest known written record of whiskey comes from Ireland in 1405



1987

The Balvenie is released as a 50 year old whisky, one of the industry's first bottling of such great age

William Grant's spirit

In 1886, William Grant built his Speyside distillery in the Glen of Fiddich, Gaelic for "the valley of the deer." The first spirit flowed from the stills on Christmas Day of 1887

Kirin Fuji, Japan is the largest distillery in the world, located at the base of Mount Fuji

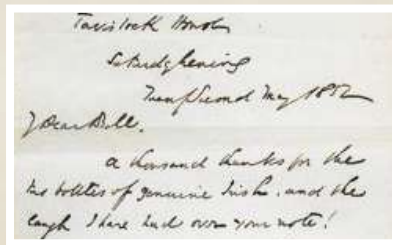

It sits at the head of a broad U-shaped bay that shares its name. Its very name in Scotch Gaelic, At-Oban, means “little bay.” The island of Kerrera almost closes off the bay creating a particularly calm anchorage

Jura has 6000 – 7000 red deer, controlled by seven estates. The deer are considered to have amongst the purest genetics of all red deer in Scotland

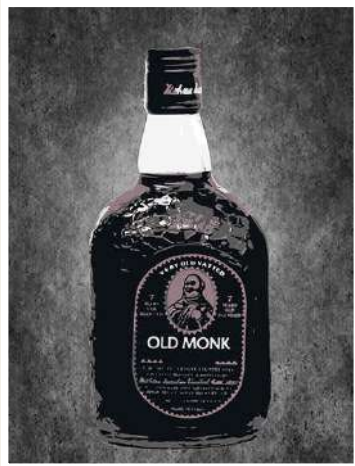

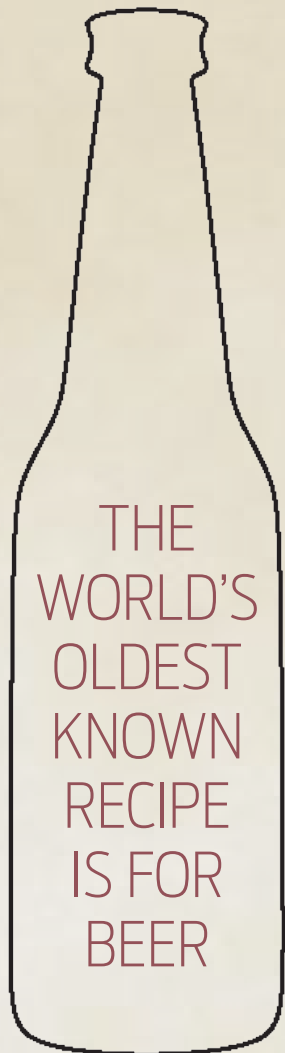
THE STORY OF BEER

RUM & PIRATES

Did you know, that some of the earliest records of mixologists were actually pirates?

During their long voyages out to sea, the pirates needed something to prevent their crew from falling ill. They had to purify the bacteria-ridden rum, by mixing it with water and adding squeezed lemon juice and mixing it all up with sugar for flavour



Bloody Mary was thought to be a Hangover Cure

Whiskey Sour

Vice Admiral Edward Vernon of England began mixing a few ingredients together and served it to his crew, "help combat sea-sickness, malnutrition, and scurvy. As they didn't want an entire ship of intoxicated sailors, they began to water it down with lemon or lime juice. While the British used Gin and Brandy, Americans favored Whiskey, and thus the Whiskey Sour was born



Negroni

In recent years, the Negroni has risen in popularity in the mixological community, and it has now joined the Dry Martini and the Manhattan to form the Triple Crown of classic cocktails



THE MARTINI GLASS ONLY GOT ITS NAME IN THE 1990S, WHEN MARTINI-STYLE COCKTAILS BECAME ALL THE RAGE
