Tasting Notes

Chosen from a reserve of over seven million casks, only nine distilleries - six malt and three grain whiskies - are represented in The John Walker. These include some of the last priceless, remaining casks from the distiller's stocks of malt whisky from Glen Albyn, closed in 1983, and grain whisky from Cambus, which closed in 1993. Unlike any other Johnnie Walkerblend, the whiskies then come together for a second and final maturation to marry the blend in a loo year-old wood cask. Each single barrel batch ("no two batches will ever be exactly the same", the company emphasized) fills just 330 individually numbered, hand-blown Baccarat crystal decanters. Just 10 of these have been made available in India, and World of Whisky has one more available.

Johnnie Walker

Originally known as Walker's Kilmarnock Whisky, the Johnnie Walker brand is a legacy left by John 'Johnnie' Walker after he started to sell whisky in his grocer's shop in Ayrshire, Scotland. The brand became popular, but after Walker's death in 1857 it was his son Alexander Walker and grandson Alexander Walker II who were largely responsible for establishing the scotch as a popular brand. It is the most widely distributed brand of blended Scotch whisky in the world, sold in almost every country with yearly sales of over 130 million bottles

BLENDED SCOTCH

Scotland has internationally protected the term "Scotch". For a whisky to be labelled Scotch it has to be produced in Scotland. Scotch is made from a blend of grain & malted barley & is often blend of different whiskies.

SINGLE MALTS

Single malt whiskies are considered to be the best of their kind and tend to reflect the climate and geographical characteristics of the region they come from.

"Single" indicates that all the malts in the bottle come from a single distillery.

"Malt" indicates that the whiskey is distilled from a single "malted" grain. Not all grains can be malted Rye is a grain that can be malted but in the case of single malt Scotch, barley is always the grain used.

The main regions Highland, Islay, Island, Lowland and Speyside have been selected. So enjoy your single malt drum.

HIGHLAND SINGLEMALTS

The highland region is the largest scotch producing region. As a group these single malt whiskies are well, robust and dry in character with a hint of smokiness. Those in coastal location carry a hint of the sea, in the far north a light and spicy character can be found. While those from the sheltered east and midland has more fruity character.

Lowland whiskies tend to be drier and lighter than most other malt whiskies. They are also very light in peat, salt and smoke as compared to whiskies from other regions. Lowland whiskeys are thought to be excellent options for "beginners."
